#### COVID-19 Cases in Wisconsin

- Positive: 457
- Negative: 8237
- Calumet County: 1
  - Appleton City Health Department Jurisdiction
  - The one confirmed case contracted the virus through domestic travel, to an area already experiencing community spread.
- Deaths: 5
- Community spread has been identified in Fond du Lac County and Walworth County.

- On March 22, Gov. Tony Evers ordered the suspension of certain Department of Public Instruction (DPI) and Public Service Commission (PSC) administrative rules due to the COVID-19 outbreak.
  - [Emergency Order #10](#) suspends [several administrative rules](#) for DPI related to hours of instruction, student teacher assessments, and general flexibility during the public health emergency.
  - [Emergency Order #11](#) suspends several [utility-related administrative rules](#) administrative rules, which paves the way for PSC to temporarily order further consumer protections, including a stop to utility disconnection for nonpayment for all customers.

Evers' orders for restriction of mass gatherings remains critically important. These efforts will help delay local community transmission in our area.
