- On March 22, Gov. Tony Evers ordered the suspension of certain Department of Public Instruction (DPI) and Public Service Commission (PSC) administrative rules due to the COVID-19 outbreak.
 - [Emergency Order #10](#) suspends [several administrative rules](#) for DPI related to hours of instruction, student teacher assessments, and general flexibility during the public health emergency.
 - [Emergency Order #11](#) suspends [several utility-related administrative rules](#) administrative rules, which paves the way for PSC to temporarily order further consumer protections, including a stop to utility disconnection for nonpayment for all customers.

Reminders

- What does “Flatten the Curve” mean; and how is the state defining “success” for Wisconsinites?
 - Success is simply this: We must stop the continual rise of disease transmission to keep the number COVID-19 cases requiring hospitalization BELOW the number of available hospital beds. We must do this by slowing the spread of disease thru our proactive measures such as “social distancing.” We cannot let this virus overrun our hospitals and available medical staffing like what has happened in countries like Italy, or certain areas of the United States. We must slow the spread of this disease because, as you know, there is no current vaccine or treatment for COVID-19.
- Where can I find the most up-to-date case counts by county?
 - The most recent numbers are pulled from WEDSS daily at noon, and the [DHS Outbreaks in Wisconsin](#) website is updated with those counts daily at 2 p.m.
- Although there is currently no evidence of community transmission in Calumet County, there is in other areas of our state. Following public health guidelines for [social distancing](#) and Gov. Evers' orders for restriction of mass gatherings remains critically important. These efforts will help delay local community transmission in our area.
- Call your healthcare provider before going into a clinic if you are experiencing mild to moderate symptoms of COVID-19. This will allow them to provide guidance, prepare ahead if you need to be seen, and minimize risk to others.
